

**President:** Thank FATHER and MOTHER for an inspiration: "This church is dedicated to Righteousness." And this is why we are so happy-love.

**President:** Peace FATHER, Peace MOTHER, Peace everyone: We thank our FATHER and MOTHER to be gathered here again for this wonderful occasion. We know that FATHER and MOTHER are present here with us and we truly thank YOU Dear. Before we move on to our next part of business, I thank FATHER and MOTHER to read a certain portion of FATHER's Words from the book: "The Peace Mission Movement as Explained by FATHER DIVINE."

"We Respect and Revere the American Flag. We will keep the flag of liberty lifted high by living our Constitution and our Bill of Rights."

"It does not necessarily mean that you shall necessarily lift up the flag from a personal point of view, (FATHER demonstrates by lifting a small American flag off of the Communion Table and holding it in the air. HE replaces it and then says:) but the symbol of the Flag of the Free shall be seen in every land as we keep the Flag lifted high in honor and respect, by living our Constitution and our Bill of Rights. Can you not see the mystery?"

"By living the Golden Rule and by enacting the Bill of Rights in all you say and in all you do you are lifting the Flag high, and eventually the symbol of the Flag of the Free shall be seen in every land!"

(October 5, 1945 A.D.F.D.)

"In all of the places they carry the American flag. Aren't you glad. Even among the enemy nations, those of the nations that were our enemy nations, MY Message of Democracy, Brotherhood and Christianity and Americanism has been carried into these nations and they carry the flag." September 11, 1948 A.D.F.D.

"An American flag of suitable size shall be properly displayed in this church auditorium at all times."

**Church Discipline, Constitution and By-Laws**

"We are Interracial, Interdenominational, Non-sectarian and Non-partisan. We believe every man has the inalienable rights to vote and worship according to the dictates of his own conscience.

Though you may be different in religious affiliations, you may be different in political affiliations, but when you are living democracy, bro-

therhood and Christianity you will stand for the man that stands for that which is just and right and you will be free from partisanism, sectarianism, racism and every abominable ism that spells division. We shall unite the people together. We shall integrate men of business, profession, labor and trade in all professions and in every field of activity they shall be integrated and united and amalgamated as I have them jurisdictionally. And no man will be handicapped or prohibited from the access of expression because of the racial abstraction or complexion. Aren't you glad!

I AM happy to cooperate with this church, and as I have been invited to do so, and as they cooperate with ME and we cooperate together we will expand and extend this brotherhood from shore to shore and from land to land. No longer trying to condemn one legal, partisan party for the other as a party, that is what I AM talking about, but we shall stand up for that which is just and right, and believe in true Americanism, Christianity, Judaism and Democracy as synonymous."

October 18, 1950 A.D.F.D.



### INDIANS' LAND GETS NEW LIFE

Farmington, N.M.—Centuries ago Indians operated fertile farms in what is now northwestern New Mexico but the climate changed, the forested land became parched desert, and they abandoned the land.

Today modern technology is returning water to the arid soil.

The Navajo Indian irrigation project aimed at converting 110,630 acres of overgrazed range into sprinkler-irrigated farmland, is becoming a reality.

The Navajos whose main agricultural activity previously was herding sheep, will celebrate the irrigation breakthrough at dedication ceremonies.

The project was authorized by Congress in

1962 and funded by tribal and federal money, with technical help from various foundations. It is in the New Mexico portion of the nation's largest Indian reservation, which also extends into Arizona and Utah. There are about 150,000 Navajos on the reservation.

Planting of grain is under way on the first of 11 blocks of land of about 10,000 acres each. All 11 blocks are expected to be under cultivation by 1985, eventually giving employment to about 6,000 persons.

The Navajos have secured the right to divert 508,000 acre feet of water annually to Navajo Reservoir. From there, the water is delivered through 38 miles of tunnels, siphons and canals and then received by the soil through sprinklers.

#### HOW MUCH U.S. GOVT. EMPLOYEES ARE ALLOWED TO SPEND WHEN THEY TRAVEL

A U.S. government employe who has to travel to Dallas, Tex., on duty is allowed to spend \$33 a day on food, lodging and local travel.

But if he's sent to Alexandria, Egypt, he'll get only \$20 a day, and if his trip takes him to some remote sections of Alaska he may be allowed as much as \$100 a day.

A special department of the General Services Administration in Washington figures out exact allowances for various areas around the world — in careful detail. For example, if a government employe goes to Brooklyn, N. Y., he can spend \$39 a day.


But just across the river in Manhattan, he's allowed \$50, and 15 miles west in Newark, his allowance sinks to \$33.

The cheapest place he can visit on a government tab is Swan Island, in the Caribbean off the coast of Honduras, where he can spend only \$12 a day. Other foreign areas: Paris, \$59; Yellowknife, Canada, \$55; Hong Kong, \$50; Seoul, Korea, \$47; Bangladesh, \$46.

In U.S. cities, the allowance per day is \$42 in Washington, D.C., \$39 in San Francisco and Chicago, \$38 in Boston and Atlantic City, \$37 in Los

Angeles, \$35 in Miami, \$28 in Burlington, Vt., and \$24 in Manchester, N.H.

**Q: What about milk? We love it and drink it with meals. Is there such a thing as too much milk?**

**A: A good question. Let's talk about milk.**

84-YEAR-OLD INDIAN SUCCESS  
AS OILMAN

New York—Willie Cry is an 84-year-old Ponca Indian who lives with one of his daughters in Ponca City, Okla. He speaks English but prefers the Ponca language among old friends. He knows the old tribal ways, but knows the modern world as well.

Willie Cry also is a shrewd oilman. His lease has produced for 65 years, yielding about half a billion barrels of oil, and giving him a comfortable living. It still thrives, although declining production must be boosted by water injection.

How much longer the lease will thrive depends on when operating costs exceed the income it generates.

Oil first was discovered on Willie Cry's 120-acre allotment of the Ponca reservation in 1911 by E. W. Marland, a famous oilman who founded the 101 Ranch Oil Co. Along with the famed Miller Brothers, who owned the huge ranch. The Marland company now is part of Continental Oil Co.

Cry was only 19 at the time, so his contract with Marland had to be signed for him by the local Indian agent.

Marland had spotted a hill on Cry's allotment near Bois D'Arc Creek which he thought a likely prospect. He drilled and struck oil at 1,560 feet. It wasn't a big well, only 200 barrels a day, but it was the first commercial-sized well in Kay County, an area destined to become one of the country's biggest oil producing regions.

Willie Cry was paid \$1,000, a modest yearly rental on his land and a 12½ percent royalty on all the oil produced.

Several more modest producers were drilled on Cry's land, then in 1918, Marland went down 3,800 feet and hit a much bigger deposit.

Production slowed after 1955 and by the end of 1962, nearly all Cry's wells had been temporarily abandoned but Cry was in very comfortable circumstances by that time and, anyway, he was making money growing wheat.


But Conoco soon brought the oil wells back into production by including them in what was called the Mississippi Chat water-flooding program. His famous 1918 well No. 9 was chosen as the injector well for the water flooding, which proved immediately successful.

## Costs Too Much

The future of Willie Cry's oil wells is in doubt now, however. Today, the federal government controls the price of domestic oil and tries to keep the price down. Water injection is a relatively expensive way to produce oil so it seems likely it's only a question of the time until the wells cease to produce enough oil to justify continuing to pump them and sell the oil at the government controlled price.

But Willie Cry doesn't seem much worried. Although he has owned some expensive automobiles and fine horses in his day, he never has cared much for fancy living.

He is known as a pretty shrewd businessman but acquaintances say he seems a lot more interested in the history and customs of his tribe and in his family than in business. He is especially interested in the Ponca tribal songs and dances and the rituals and remedies of the Ponca medicine men.

He has one special distinction. He is one of the few living Poncas who has seen the sun dance performed. He says it has been more than half a century since it was last performed and on the day he saw it as a boy, "The sun turned blue in the heavens. There are things I know that most people would not believe or understand," he added.

About half of the Philadelphia Museum of Art's permanent galleries were closed recently because there weren't enough security guards to protect the museum's treasures.

Among the galleries closed were these containing the English, Italian and French period rooms, Indian sculpture and Chinese ceramics. The gallery featuring the popular Japanese Tea-house also was closed.

The museum's newly opened feature exhibit for the Bicentennial, "300 Years of American Art," remained open.

The Social Democratic Center has only 16 delegates in the 250-member assembly.

The head of the Communist Party hailed the document as "consecrating full democratic liberties and . . . the fundamental rights of the workers . . . and pointing the country on a road to a socialist society."

The constitution calls for a "classless society," collective ownership of the means of production, land and natural resources, and bars reversal of nationalizations that have brought nearly 70% of the economy under government control since a leftist military coup that toppled the right-wing regime of Premier Marcello Caetano in April 1974.

U. S. POSTAGE

The U. S. Postal Service begins charging one-third more for special delivery, registered mail, insured mail and other special services.

The increases: special delivery, 60 cents to 80 cents; registered mail, minimum, 95 cents to \$1.25; insured mail — liability up to \$15, 20 cents to 25 cents; liability up to \$200, 60 cents to 80 cents; money order minimum, 25 cents to 30 cents; special handling, up to two pounds, 25 cents to 30 cents; up to 10 pounds, 35 cents to 45 cents, and over 10 pound, 50 cents to 65 cents. The postal service said these and other rate increases going into effect are "temporary," pending approval by the Postal Rate Commission.

GROUPS CAMPAIGNING  
FOR SCHOOL PRAYERS

Concord, N.H.—A disjointed movement is afoot in America to return prayer to the schoolroom.

Small, local bands of citizens are raising their voices to demand that schools provide time, and in some cases guidance, for religious observance.

There appears to be no coordinated national effort. But in the 14 years since the U.S. Supreme Court decided it was unconstitutional for children to pray in schools, nearly 30 states have instituted, or are exploring, ways to get religion back into the classroom.

Within the past two years at least 15 states have enacted laws allowing periods of silent meditation in public school classes.

The form and function of the meditation periods vary, but the prevailing belief of those supporting the movement is that religion cannot be excised from the historical and moral fabric of American society. Supporters of pro-prayer measures argue that the United States is truly "One nation under God" and that a strict separation of church and state is futile.

Those who want prayer in public schools say they are perplexed by the contradiction of getting prayers out of the classroom but not out of other American institutions.

Rita Warren of Brockton, Mass., a pro-prayer activist, says: "Every piece of money in this country says: 'In God We Trust' and that's a prayer." Mrs. Warren, who has taken her campaign around New England and to Washington, is leading a drive for a constitutional amendment to allow prayer in public schools.

New Hampshire Gov. Meldrim Thomson, a strong prayer-in-the-school advocate, points out the U.S. Congress and other legislative bodies open their deliberations with prayer.

After a recent federal court ruling declaring New Hampshire's year-old school prayer law "patently unconstitutional," Thomson said he would not give up the fight to have some type of meditation in the state's public schools. He said a new law would be written avoiding a direct constitutional confrontation.


New Hampshire's first attempt to deal with the 1962 Supreme Court ruling turned recitation of the Lord's Prayer into an historical exercise. Students were reminded at the opening of devotional exercises that "this Lord's Prayer is the prayer the Pilgrim fathers recited when they came to this country."

Several states have followed the lead of Pennsylvania's four-year-old law and left the matter up to teachers to decide whether to allow the class to meditate or even pray silently.

Five New Jersey high schools offer courses in Transcendental Meditation, although the state legislature has made no attempts to sanction school prayer, meditation or other religious activity.

The courses are experimental and authorized by the state education department and were not intended to bypass the Supreme Court ruling, officials say.

Giant farm corporations—used by the wealthy as tax shelters — are wiping out family-owned farms, reveal angry congressmen and top economists.

"This incredible tax dodge allows rich city investors to funnel a large chunk of their income into specially created farm corporations, then deduct it as a 'business expense' — thereby avoiding payment of taxes on the money.

"The setup has proven a bonanza for the rich, who work the tax ledgers instead of the land," fumed Congressman Richard Nolan (D.-Minn.).

"It's another example of high-pressure, high-income groups manipulating the law at the expense of almost everyone else.

"The amount of money we are losing on taxes because of this shelter is incredibly large. It'll add up to well over \$1 billion by the end of 1981."

A study of the situation was made by economists Stephen Matthews and V. James Rhodes of the University of Missouri. Both feel this tax shelter should be eliminated.

"We found that the large majority of investors are lawyers and doctors — people who have nothing to do with farming," said Matthews. "Their only purpose for joining is to get the tax benefits and maybe make money.

"Most of these partnerships are in the cattle growing area, and most of the money invested is spent on feed — because the IRS considers feed a business expense, so it becomes a legitimate tax deduction."

Rep. Nolan says he's introduced a bill that would prohibit corporation members from writing off farm losses against nonfarm income.

"What I'm trying to do is even it off, so that the person who earns his livelihood from farming has at least a fighting chance," he explained.

"Besides hurting the small farmer, big corporations also ultimately mean higher food prices for consumers."

Sen. Bill Brock (R.-Tenn.) agrees that the farm tax shelter must be eliminated.

"Tax loopholes that allow hobby farmers to deduct a large portion from their tax returns is an example of shortsighted thinking," said Brock. "Such allowances merely make it more difficult for the family farmer to compete — or even exist."

## SCHOOL WOES BLAMED ON TV

Washington — Bored and unruly students, expecting entertainment instead of education, are the cause of many problems of the nation's schools. National Education Association president John Ryor said recently.

"This is not a copout, but educators are tired of taking of all the blame for problems," Ryor told a National Town Meeting audience.


Ryor, a former high school math teacher, said much of the cause of declining student performance is lack of support and motivation in the home and in the students themselves. He assigned a share of the blame to television.

"Young people spend more time with the 'idiot box' than with their parents or in schools," he said. The average high school student upon graduation has spent 15,000 hours in front of a television set, compared to 12,000 hours in the classroom.

**PE STOCK LAKE AT MUDDY RUN  
 WITH TROUT**

Five thousand trout in a 100-acre lake are expected to attract a lot of anglers to Muddy Run Recreation Park, located on Route 372 in Lancaster County, about three miles west of Route 272. Philadelphia Electric Company has stocked the lake at Muddy Run every trout season since the popular family outing spot opened in 1969.

This year, the Company announced that about 3,000 of the fish will be in the water before April

17, opening day of trout season, and the remainder will be stocked later to assure good fishing throughout the spring. The 5,000 brook trout are all legal, ranging in size from nine to twenty inches.

In addition to the trout, more than thirty species of fish are found in the lake including large and small-mouth bass, northern pike, bluegills, white crappies, and sunfish. Pennsylvania licenses are required, and they can be purchased, along with bait, at the general store in the park.

David Ellenberg, superintendent of Muddy Run

Park, said all facilities are open including the snack bar, picnic areas with grills, and boat rentals. No gasoline power boats are permitted. All sites in the camping area have been reserved for the first weekend of trout season according to Ellenberg, but sites are available during week days. Camping reservations may be made by calling 717/284-4325 or writing to: Muddy Run Recreation Park, Holtwood, R.D. 1, Pennsylvania, 17532.

Philadelphia Electric also announced that controlled access for fishing will be permitted to a portion of the 900-acre reservoir, which provides water for the Muddy Run pumped storage plant. A third fishing spot in the complex is Fishermen's Park, on the Susquehanna River adjacent to the powerhouse. Maps and information on all the facilities are available at the recreation park office.

**CHLOROFORM BAN**

The Food and Drug Administration plans to ban the use of chloroform in toothpaste, cough medicine and all items because of a new government study that indicates it may cause cancer. The ban, which would take effect July 8, would affect the approximately 2,000 items on the market that contain the drug.
